

ORDINANCE FOR PEDESTRIAN CURFEW

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen have determined that the needs of the City of Carthage require the adoption of an Ordinance for Pedestrian Curfew for the City of Carthage, Mississippi;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF CARTHAGE, MISSISSIPPI, AS FOLLOWS:

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen have determined that a public safety issue has arisen as a result of pedestrians out walking at all hours.

Pedestrians are hereby prohibited from walking in the City of Carthage from 11:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect one (1) month from and after its passage.

The foregoing Ordinance having been reduced to writing and having been read and considered by Section and then as a whole, Alderwoman, Miracle Matlock moved to adopt same by Sections and as a whole. Alderman, David Cocroft seconded the motion to adopt the Ordinance, and the Mayor having called the question to vote, the following vote was recorded:

Laurie Henderson voting "Aye"
David Herrington voting "Aye"
Miracle Matlock voting "Aye"

The Mayor declared the motion to have been carried and the Ordinance to have been adopted, and directed the publication thereof.
